The events will be held at the Recreational and Physical Activity Center (RPAC) 337 Annie & John Glenn Avenue on the campus of The Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio.

First at 9:00 am, NFL Moms, and guests will get *Charg'd Up* with an exuberating cardio workout led by former NFL Player, fitness expert and creator of *Charg'd Up*, **Philipé Philly Weeden**.

At 11:00 am, following the morning workout, "NEXT LEVEL UP, Begin With the End in Mind", where all high school and college students attending the Next Level Up session will receive free admission to the game. This signature PFPMA program will feature virtual guest appearances from NFL Hall Of Famer, Jerome Bettis, current NFL players, New Orleans Saints Safety Malcolm Jenkins, and Cleveland Browns Corner, Denzel Ward. Live on-site panel, moderated by Obie Stillwell, will include former NFL Players, and mothers of Current and Former NFL Players, including, Jay Richardson (former Oakland Raiders), Josh Cribbs, (former Cleveland Browns), Philipé Philly Weeden, (former Baltimore Ravens), Gladys Bettis, Gwendolyn V.
